Changed Immunization Requirements

Ohio law now requires that all students entering seventh grade have proof of receiving the following immunizations BEFORE the first day of school: TDaP vaccine (to protect from Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) and Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccine (to protect from Meningitis). Any seventh grade student who has not had both the TDaP and Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccinations will not be permitted to attend school until proof of these immunizations has been provided to the school.

Ohio law requires that all students entering twelfth grade have proof of receiving the following immunizations BEFORE the first day of school: Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccine (to protect from Meningitis). Students entering twelfth grade must have a second dose of Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccine. If the first dose of Meningococcal was administered after the sixteenth birthday, a second dose is not required. Students will not be permitted to attend school until proof of these immunizations has been provided to the school.

Immunizations may be obtained from your child's healthcare provider, most local pharmacies, and the Stark County Health Department. Please submit a copy of your child's immunization or a signed form to the school nurse prior to the first day of school.

Child Find Early Childhood Screening Program

Each year school districts throughout Ohio participate in an effort to identify, locate and evaluate all children with disabilities, birth through 21. A disability means there are conditions such as a multi-handicap, hearing, visual, orthopedic and/or other health handicap, severe behavior disorder and/or speech/language handicap. Many times children with disabilities are not visible because they do not function in the mainstream of a community. Parents are not always aware that there are programs and services available for these children.

District Improvements

Our school district passed a Permanent Improvement Levy in 2013, which provides approximately \$1.5 million for expenditures each year. This funding has allowed us to make the following purchases for Fiscal Year 2017:

- One new school bus purchased that has a wheelchair lift: \$85,492.
- Replacement of a roof section at Hoover High School \$244,724. This project replaced a large section of original roof over the portion of the high school constructed in 1976.
- Roof repairs at Clearmount Elementary School: \$ 21,056.
